Subject: No Gift Policy

According to the Cabinet resolution on December 8, 2020, the country's reform plan for preventing and suppressing corruption and misconduct was approved. (Revised edition) with a drive to carry out important reform activities (Big Rock). Reform activity number 4: Develop the Thai bureaucracy to be transparent and free of benefits. Goal No. 1, Section 1.1, "Have all government agencies declare themselves to be agencies in which all government officials do not accept gifts and gifts of any kind in the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy)".

In this regard, to drive reform activities according to the national reform plan above. Including creating transparency within the agency. Create correct values and attitudes in performing duties that should be practiced to create an honest culture of the organization Napansam Subdistrict Administrative Organization Therefore, a policy has been established for all executives, employees, officers, and personnel under their supervision not to accept gifts and gifts of any kind from performing their duties (No Gift Policy) on every occasion, festival, and various special occasions, both before, during, and after performing their duties in every case. Will result in corruption. and misconduct both now and in the future in order to avoid actions that may affect judgment or decision-making which leads to discrimination or creates a risk of conflict of interest By strictly adhering to the said policy for transparency in operations. and provide maximum benefit to the government and to the people According to the regulations of the Office of the Prime Minister regarding giving or receiving gifts by government officials, B.E. 2001, together with the announcement of the National Anti-Corruption Commission on the criteria for accepting property or any other benefits according to the ethics of government officials, B.E. 2020

Therefore, this announcement has been made for everyone's knowledge and for all executives, officers and personnel to strictly follow the policy.
